Size Guide See What Fits





What is the right size for my cover?

Consider the space between the vehicles. There should be enough space between the vehicles such that the doors to each car can be opened freely without hitting or touching the other vehicle. We recommend that you measure the width of each vehicle to be covered and add 4' - 5' for each vehicle.

Suggestion:

12' Wide: 1 Car, Truck or SUV

• 18' Wide: 2 Compact cars

20' Wide: 2 Mid size cars, Trucks or SUVS

22' Wide: 2 Full Size cars, Trucks or SUVS

· 24' Wide: 2 Full or oversized vehicles

· 26' Wide: 3 Mid size cars



30' Wide: 3 Mid size cars, Trucks or SUVS





Things to consider when purchasing a metal building, barn, or garage that affect pricing:

- What size and style you are in the market for.
- Do you want vertical or horizontal walls?
- Do you want wainscoting?
- Do you want the structure insulated?
- What size Roll up doors would you want?
- What size windows would you want?
- How many walk in doors would you want?



Double legs are recommended for buildings 11' - 14' in height.

Ladder legs are recommended for buildings 15' or taller in height.

** We will need to know exact Roll Up Door placement when you place your order. The walk-in doors & windows can be decided at time of installation. **

Metal Color Chart:

You Can Choose a Roof Color, Trim Color, Wall Color, & Wainscot Color. (Vertical

wainscot is an additional charge)



Components:



A transition piece covering the ridge of the roof. The ridge cap is normally color matched with the roof panels.

Customer can change color, but it must be specified.


Hat Channels:

A galvanized steel component that is used to create a vertical roof orientation. The hat channel also provides more rigidness for a stronger structure

Bows:

A single piece of square tubing used to make the roofing member of a building. The tubing can be made from either 14 gauge or a 12 gauge steel

12 Components:



Braces:

Braces are U-shaped channels that are used to reinforce the structure of a building. For buildings in which the braces are optional we recommend 2' braces on buildings shorter than 8' tall and 3' braces for buildings 9' or taller.

Base Rails:

The square tubing on the base of the building onto which the legs are attached to.

Leg Post & Trim:

Legs are the vertical tubing that connect the bows (top) to the base rail (bottom). The leg height varies depending on the type of building.

Trim to give the roof and building corners a finished and a more aesthetic view.

- 10 Year limited Rust Through Warranty
- 90 Day Workmanship Warranty
- 20 Year Metal Sheeting, Paint Warranty from fading, bubbling, and chipping.

Materials & Anchors:








Our buildings are made with commercial grade square tubing in 14GA (2.5") and 12GA (2.25") steel.

All tubing is galvanized during the manufacturing process to prevent surface rust. We carry 26GA and 29GA Ridged sheet metal that is coated with Sherwin Williams Paints which provides all our customers with an exclusive 20yr Paint Warranty, protecting the product from fading, bubbling, and chipping.



Upgraded anchoring options such as:

✓ Mobile Home Anchors (add'l charge)

(MHA) are 30inch long corkscrew anchors that are specifically designed for ground, gravel. and grass foundation.

Asphalt Anchors

Are 30inch long with a barbed shaft that are specifically designed for asphalt, solid limestone, and compacted rock foundation.

✓ Concrete Anchors

Are wedge-style bolts that are 6inch long and $\frac{1}{2}$ inch in diameter with a 5/8 head. They are specifically designed for concrete foundation.



To ensure you receive the best installation possible, **PLEASE READ THIS PAGE**.

For a run to be successful, we count on you to ensure beforehand that your site is ready for installation. The following are the things to consider:

- Make sure you site is level or no more than 3" off level. If it is unlevel we need to know upfront so that we know if you need the legs cut on site.
- The install crew will be pulling a 30' to 36' trailer. Maneuvering into small
 or steep driveways may very well not be doable. Please advise us if you
 think that this is a concern.
- If unit is to be installed on a concrete pad, please let us know as soon as the pad is ready. If it has not been poured yet, please let us know of a time frame you think the pad will be ready.
 - Option 1: A concrete pad the same size as the frame of the building.
 For Example, If you purchase a 20x30 unit, build a concrete pad that is 20' wide x 30' in length
 - Option 2: A concrete pad with a 1.5-inch ledge. For Example, if you purchase a 20x30 unit, build a concrete pad that is 20' wide and 30' in length and have your concrete contractor make an additional 1.5-inch ledge all the way around. This will make your slab 3 inches longer and 3 inches wider than the base. This will allow the metal to go down past the floor to prevent water from coming in at the bottom. In construction terms, this is what is called a "brick ledge." In total, with the ledge the slab would be 20'-3"x30'-3".
- Inquire upfront if you need any special building permits. Some counties
 or towns have websites you can visit for all the paperwork needed (if any)
 before installation.

5 Financing & RTO Options:

We offer multiple Rent To Own and Financing

EZ Pay RTO

- A credit check will only be necessary for structures with an RTO amount over \$12,000.00.
- A credit score of 600 or higher is needed to proceed if a credit check is required.
- Max amount able to finance through RTO is \$20,000.00.
 Anything over that would have to be paid down.
